

What is 'Grèko in Galliciano'?

The location-based game "Grèko in Galliciano" is an activity dedicated to people visiting Grèko speaking area in Calabria - especially the village of Galliciano.

Where to play?

You must be in the village of Galliciano and follow the route (game board).

How much time does it take?

It is planned to be a simultaneous activity during the tour in Galliciano with a local guide and the approximate time to play the game is 2 hours.

What do I need to play?

No special equipment is required. You just need this board and a pen.

Guidelines:

It is enough to follow carefully your guide, to listen to him and to follow all places shown during the tour. Follow the number of each task on the game board!

Rules of the game:

1. You have 10 tasks to do. You obtain 3 points for each correctly performed task.
2. Write your answers in the table on the right.
3. At the end of the tour you will be given the correct answers and you will be able to evaluate your achievements.
